## Recycle your Christmas tree

From now until Jan. 16, you can recycle your Christmas tree through Denver's [Treecycle](#) program. Your tree will be turned into mulch, which will be available to Denver residents for free at the annual Mulch Giveaway in the spring. Last holiday season, more than 20,000 trees were recycled in Denver. Help recycle even more this year!

Set your tree out (real, evergreens only), following these instructions:

Remove decorations and tree stand.

Place tree on ground (not in dumpster or cart) at least 2 feet away from all obstacles for collection.

Set out your tree based on your trash service type.

Manual and cart customers: Set trees out near your normal trash set-out location by 7 a.m. on your trash collection day during the weeks of Jan. 5 or Jan. 12.

Dumpster customers: Set trees out in the alley by 7 a.m. on either Monday, Jan. 5, or Monday, Jan. 12, for collection sometime during that week.

Reclaim free mulch at the annual [Mulch Giveaway](#), scheduled for Saturday, May 2, 2015.
